

**VTEA NOMINATION FOR TECHNOLOGY PROGRAM OF THE YEAR
Middle School and High School Awards**

Nominations are being accepted for the award of Technology Education Program of the Year. Nominations must be postmarked by February 15, 2002. Submit the form below to Dr. Walter Deal, Chairperson, Program of the Year Committee. The Technology Education Program of the Year Awards acknowledge superior programs. Schools recognized serve as a standard for comparison and models for the development of improved programs. Separate recognition is provided to a program at the (a) middle school level and (b) high school level.

MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS

1. Program must be assessed using the Standards of Technology Education Programs.
2. Program nominated must be assessed by a team of at least three persons.
3. The program nominated must meet or exceed 70% of the Standards.
4. Sixty percent of the technology faculty shall be members of both the International Technology Education Association and the Virginia Technology Education Association.
5. Nominations must be submitted by the school principal.

PROCEDURES FOR NOMINATION

1. Local assessment - The technology education program shall be assessed by a local team using the form developed from the Standards for Technology Education Programs. The assessment team should include at least three people drawn from a combination of technology teachers, school administrators, guidance counselors, parents, business and industry representatives or other consultants.
2. Submit nomination with required materials to the VTEA Selection Committee in a packet which includes:
 - (a) Copy of the filled-in Standards for Technology Education Programs - Self Study
 - (b) Program excellence application materials including the six categories described on page 2 of the application packet (1997/98 revised).
 - (c) Five color slides of the Technology Education Program.
 - (d) A video tape of the school's Technology Education Program.
 - (e) The completed nomination form signed by the appropriate official.

DETERMINING THE WINNER(S)

After the VTEA Selection Committee analyzes each nomination packet and portfolio (binder with each category (6) separated by a divider that has a proper label), they will assess each program and determine the winner(s). Awardees will be notified by June 1, 2002. State Recognition will be given at the VTEA Summer Conference at the Colonial Williamsburg Resort Hotel, August 7-9, 2002. International recognition will be given at the 66th International Technology Education Conference, Nashville, Tennessee, March 13-16, 2003.
