Each year, the VTEEA recognizes members and other individuals that provide outstanding leadership and service in the field of P-16 Technology and Engineering Education. Below is a list and summary statement pertaining to each award. The VTEEA Board of Directors encourages you to review the various categories of awards and consider nominating deserving colleagues.

PROGRAM OF AWARDS

1. Retired Personnel

Recognition given to Technology and Engineering Education personnel (teachers, supervisors, and teacher educators) upon their year of retirement. Award to be presented at the annual Summer Conference following the person's retirement.

2. John Monroe Service Award

Recognition for extraordinary service to the profession and to the VTEEA by members of VTEEA. The intent of this award is to honor those members who have given service above and beyond that normally expected. Awarded to VTEEA members only. Limited to no more than two per year. (Named in honor of John Monroe 3/1/1997)

3. VTEEA Achievement Award(s)

Awarded to VTEEA members who have done exemplary work in one of several selected areas: (1) work with TSA, (2) publishing, (3) non-degree research, (4) public relations activities, and (5) encouraging students to become Technology and Engineering Education teachers.

4. Certificate of Recognition

Presented to non-member persons, associations, and businesses who have made noteworthy contributions to the VTEEA and to Technology and Engineering Education in Virginia.

5. College Membership Award

Awarded to the Virginia college or university with the highest percentage of Technology and Engineering Education majors who are VTEEA members (effective May 1 of each year).

6. Presidential Award

A discretionary award, to an individual who has made a notable contribution to Technology and Engineering Education, but has not and likely will not be the recipient of other VTEEA awards. The presidential Award is given in the spirit of appreciation to someone the current President believes deserves a special "presidential commendation." Nominations encouraged.
